# Objectives

The objectives of this partnership are:

- To exchange experiences and formulate recommendations to VET in the field of sustainable innovation, addressing the needs and realities of a wide variety of European countries
- To define the concept of a European Training Course on Eco-efficiency
- To define the concept of training courses on relevant topics within sustainable innovation, addressing critical sectors or areas, to be defined by the partnership in view of its exchanges and debates

The partnership will organize regular meetings to achieve the above mentioned objectives, involving not only the partners but also relevant players in the VET system of the hosting country. In addition, expert consultation processes will be used to optimize the results. Some events will be organized in conjunction with relevant conferences in the sustainability arena: to be highlighted the European Roundtable of Sustainable Consumption and Production (ERSCP) that will take place in 2010 (the Netherlands) and 2012 (Austria) and in which some partners are involved as organizers. This brings the opportunity to the proposed partnership for an active participation and therefore to attain significant results. The 2010 ERSCP is a joint initiative with Environmental Management for Sustainable Universities (EMSU) and its theme is particularly relevant for this project: Knowledge Collaboration and Learning for Sustainable Innovation; the partnership intends to organize a workshop in the context of this conference and draw recommendations for the European VET system.

As above mentioned, the members of this partnership collaborate in the framework of PREPARE; they will use resources of network (namely its website) to ensure a sound communication between meetings and the dissemination of projects' results, news, events and other relevant information to the partnership.
